ADMINISTRATIVE REPORT 2010-2011

1. INTRODUCTION:

State Council of Educational Research and Training (SCERT), Government of Manipur, was established by amalgamating the erstwhile State Institute of Education (S.I.E.) and State Institute of Educational Technology (SIET) and some other units from the Directorate of School Education in the month of February, 1989. The SCERT has since then been working for upliftment of the quality of education in the elementary stage of education as well as for achieving the goal of Universalisation of Elementary Education (UEE).

2. MAJOR FUNCTIONS:

- iii) To arrange appropriate programmes for the overall professional development of teachers, teacher-educators and supervisors/ inspecting officers.
- iv) To provide extension services to teacher training institutions at all levels in the state.
- v) To coordinate the work of extension services centers of the teacher training institutions in the state.
- vi) To prescribe Curricula and Textbooks for Teacher Training Institutions at the Pre-Schools and Elementary Stages.
- vii) To produce instructional materials for use of teachers & teacher educators at the Secondary and Higher Secondary Stages
- viii) To conduct action researches and school surveys in various areas of school education and Teacher Training.
- ix) To achieve Universalisation of Elementary Education (UEE) and maintain quality education by using electronic media of all kinds.
- x) To undertake specific projects at all levels of education not inconsistent with the basic objectives of the Department, and also works/assignments as entrusted to it by the Government from time to time.

XI. District Institute of Education and Training (DIET):

Under 100% Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Restructuring and Reorganization of Teacher Education (RRTE), 8(eight) District Institute of Education and Training (DIETs) are functioning at Imphal, Kakching, Churachandpur, Moirang, Senapati, Chandel, Ukhrul and Tamei. In these DIETs this Directorate is conducting the following teacher training courses/programmes.

Objectives of the Scheme: The main objectives of the Schemes are:-

- i) Upliftment of the quality of Teachers/ Instructors/ Educational Volunteers/at Elementary stage.
- ii) To give suitable academic and Resource Support to the teachers/instructors at the Elementary level which would comprise of the following activities:
 - (a) Training, Guidance and Advice, (b) Development of locally relevant teaching learning materials and teaching aids, (c) Evaluation and (d) Field studies, Action Research, Innovation etc.
 - (b) Planning and Management of Teacher Education.

The following academic programmes are implemented in the said DIETs:-

- Two years Training Course for Pre-Service Teachers (DETEd).
- ii) Six months Training Course for In-Service (CETEd).
- iii) Short Term training/ Orientation Courses for teachers on different subjects.
- iv) Workshop /Seminar for production of training modules, teacher guide books etc.
- v) Action Research and School Survey.

XII. Integrated Education for Disabled Children (IEDC):

This scheme is implemented in 8(eight) Community Development (CD) / Tribal Development (TD) Blocks with cent per cent Central Assistance:

- i) Imphal West-I CD Block, ii) Imphal West-II CD Block, iii) Imphal East-I ICDBlock,
- iv) Thoubal CD Block, v) Kakching CD Block, vi) Bishnupur CD Block, vii) Moirang CD Block and viii) Churachandpur CD Block.

Under this Scheme, disabled children of the following categories have enrolled in different schools.

i)	Orthopedically impaired	(OI)

During the year 2010-11, 1598 Disabled Children enrolled in 405 schools have been given special facilities and Education with the help of special teachers of the Directorate.
